Prairie Berry Winery Wines Now Available in North Dakota

HILL CITY, S.D. - Prairie Berry Winery is proud to announce that their most popular wines, including Red Ass Rhubarb, are now available for purchase at wine retailers throughout North Dakota.

Prairie Berry Winery has partnered with Republic National Distributing Company, the country's second largest wholesale wine and spirits distributor. The first shipment of the South Dakota-made wine left Prairie Berry Winery in Hill City, S.D. Tuesday, Jan. 23, 2018 and is currently headed to RNDC's warehouse in Fargo, N.D.

"Prairie Berry was founded in Mobridge in 1999, practically on the North Dakota border," says Matt Keck, Co-owner of Prairie Berry Winery. "We have a lot of fans up in North Dakota, many people who have come and visited us here at the winery in Hill City, have wine shipped to them directly, or are members of our wine club. I know there's a lot of people who have been waiting for us to get there and we're finally there."

Prairie Berry Winery's flagship wine, Red Ass Rhubarb, is among the wines that will be available for purchase in North Dakota. Red Ass Rhubarb is a blend of raspberries and rhubarb and has earned more than 100 awards. Other wines include Calamity Jane, a Concord grape wine and winner of a Double Gold medal at the 2018 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition, Gold Digger, made from pears, and Wild Bill, a semi-sweet wine made from Catawba grapes.
